Sealed proposals will be received by the City Clerk at the City Hall, 137 E. Main St., P.O. Box 710, Drexel, Missouri, 64742, until 2:00 p.m. on November 12, 2009 at which time proposals for construction of Water System Improvements for the City of Drexel, Missouri, will be opened and read aloud.

The work under this Contract consists of the following approximate quantities:

Contract A: Install approximately 120,900 L.F. of 10-inch waterline, pump station, complete with all piping, valves, electrical, testing, site work, fencing, and appurtenances necessary to complete the work outlined in accordance with the plans and specifications. An alternate base bid of 8-inch waterline and two pump stations. **One set of plans and project manual will be \$55.00, see below for details.**

Contract B: Install approximately 4,500 L.F. of 10-inch PVC waterline, 6,200 L.F. of 8-inch PVC waterline, and 2,200 L.F. of 6-inch PVC waterline including street crossings, service reconnections, related appurtenances and restoration. **One set of plans and project manual will be \$55.00, see below for details.**

Contract C: Work covers construction of one 250,000 gallon elevated storage tank complete with all piping valves, foundation, painting, electrical, testing, disinfecting, site work, fencing, a water sales device, appurtenances, and demolition of 50,000 gallon existing elevated tank, necessary to complete the work outlined in accordance with the plans and specifications on a site located in Drexel, Missouri. Demolition of existing elevated storage tank is to be done after new tank is in service. **One set of plans and project manual will be \$55.00, see below for details.**

Contract D: Install approximately 3,000 L.F. of 8-inch waterline, including street crossings, service reconnections, related appurtenances, and restoration. **One set of plans and project manual will be \$45.00, see below for details.**

Contract E: Provide equipment for installation of control vault, SCADA system, and appurtenances necessary to complete the work outlined in accordance with the plans and specifications. **One set of plans and project manual will be \$35.00, see below for details.**

All equipment, material and workmanship must be in accordance with the Plans, Specifications and other Contract Documents in the Project Manual on file with the City Clerk, Kara Smith, and in the office of the Consulting Engineers, LARKIN GROUP, INC., 9200 Ward Parkway, Suite 200, Kansas City, Missouri 64114.

Copies of the contract documents (Notice to Bidders, Instructions to Bidders, Proposal Form, Contract Form, Bond Forms) desired for bidding purposes may be obtained from the Consulting Engineer.

Non-Refundable Payment for Plans and Project Manual:

A non-refundable payment of will be required for each complete set of Plans and Project Manual per Contract.

A bid bond or certified check on a reputable bank in an amount equal to five (5%) per cent of the total amount of each section bid must accompany each Proposal.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of sixty (60) days after date of opening of bids.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities therein, to determine which is the lowest and best bid, to accept, at its option, any of the alternates, and to approve the bond. The Owner will decide to pursue the Base Bid or Alternate Base Bid based upon the availability of funds.

All wages paid for work under this Contract shall comply with requirements of the prevailing wage law of the State of Missouri, Missouri Public Law 294, Sec. 290.210 through 290.340, R.S. Mo. 1969, as amended, and prevailing wages as established by the U.S. Department of Labor.

Any bidder or equipment supplier whose firm or affiliate is listed on the General Services Administration (GSA) publication entitled "Lists of Parties Excluded from Federal Procurement or Nonprocurement Programs" will be prohibited from the bidding process. Anyone submitting a bid who is so listed will be determined to be a nonresponsive bidder in accordance with 40 CFR 32.

A Contractor's Suspension/Debarment Certification will be contained in the Specifications; however, this certification should not preclude any interested party from ascertaining whether the certifying firm or person is actually on the list. To determine a person's and/or firms' eligibility for award in accordance with the Debarment, Suspension, and Voluntarily Excluded Regulation, 40 CFR 52.500(b), contact the grantee's authorized representative.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order Number 11246. Requirements for Bidders and Contractors under this order are explained in the Specifications.

This project is being financed through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 and the Missouri State Revolving Fund, established by the sale of Missouri Water Pollution Control bonds and federal Capitalization Grants to Missouri.

Nondiscrimination in Employment - Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the Project Manual.
